Apprenticeships

We are proud to have been involved in the development of the first degree apprenticeship for the environment sector — Environmental Practitioner Apprenticeship Degree (Level 6). This apprenticeship is a unique way to gain breadth of experience in a diverse and fun environmental consultancy, where you will be developing your skills and knowledge while working toward a formal qualification. You will work with a range of specialists, including environmental managers, environmental impact assessors, ecologists, engineers and asset managers. As part of a project team, your role will be mostly office based, but may include some on-site work.

How do I apply? Entry requirements for this apprenticeship programme are: 5 GCSEs grades A-C / 9-5 including Maths & English. 2 A-Levels at grades A-C from the following subject options: Science, Maths, Geography, Psychology OR a BTEC Level 3 to include 6 units in a science subject.
